Print the word wheel on card stock paper for best results.

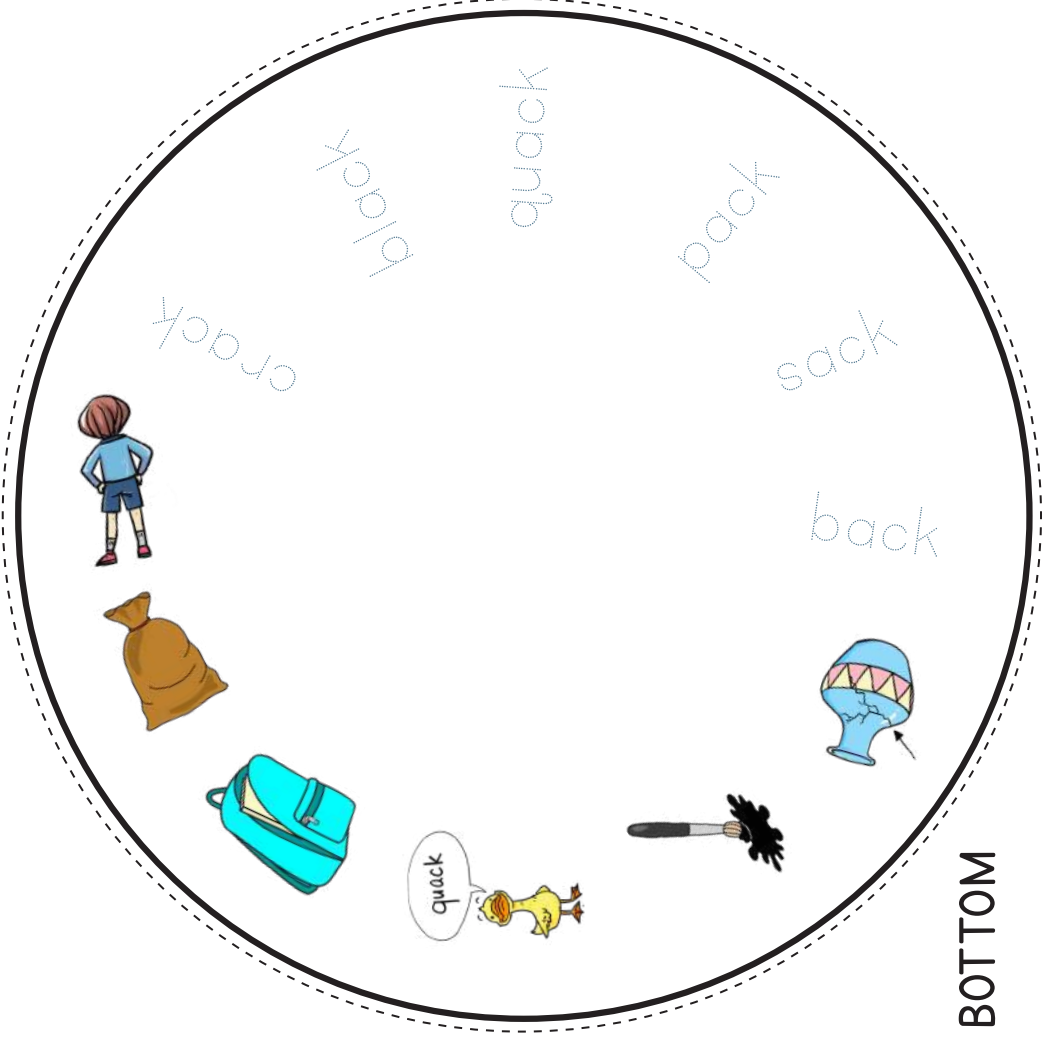
Step 2: Attach the front to the back with a brass paper fastener, paperclip, or another fastening object.

Step 3: Have your students spin the wheel to make and read the words.

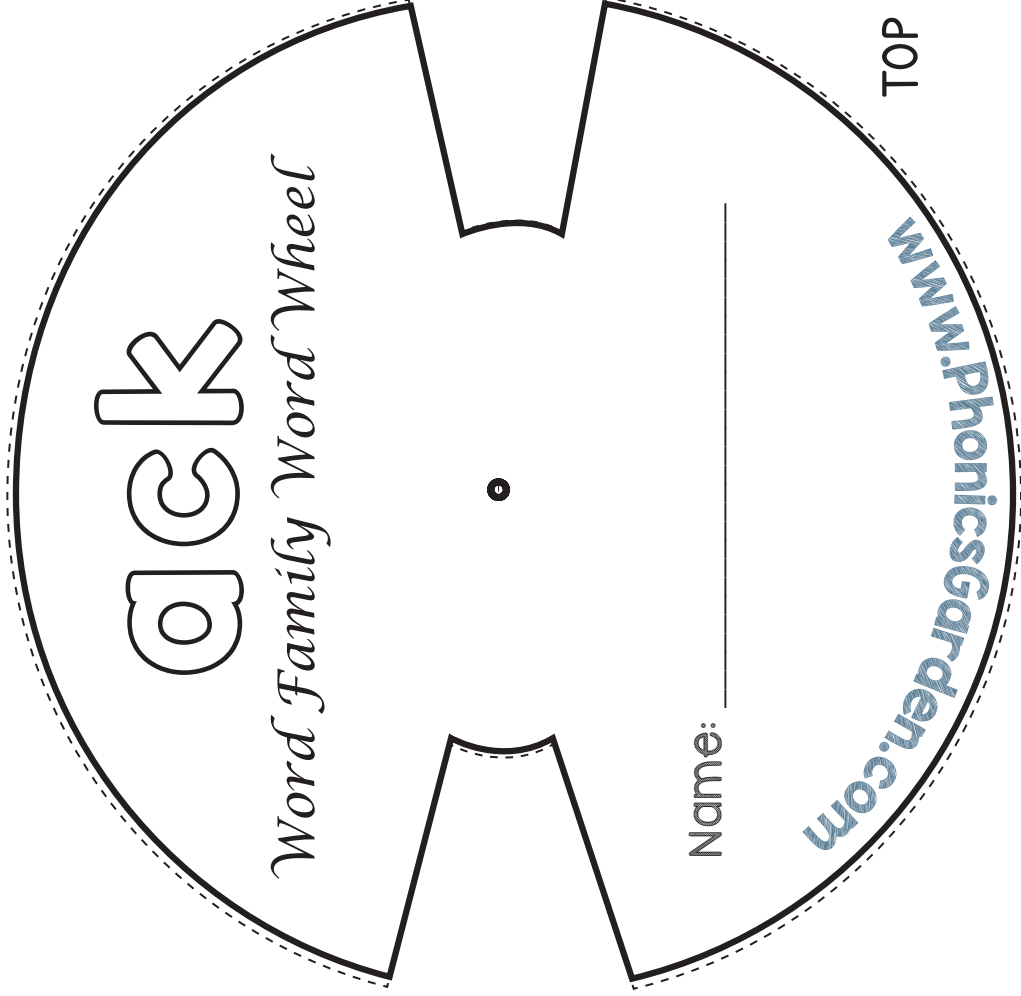


Word Wheel
