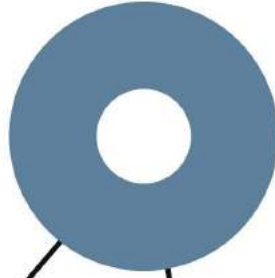






SPINNER ad word family

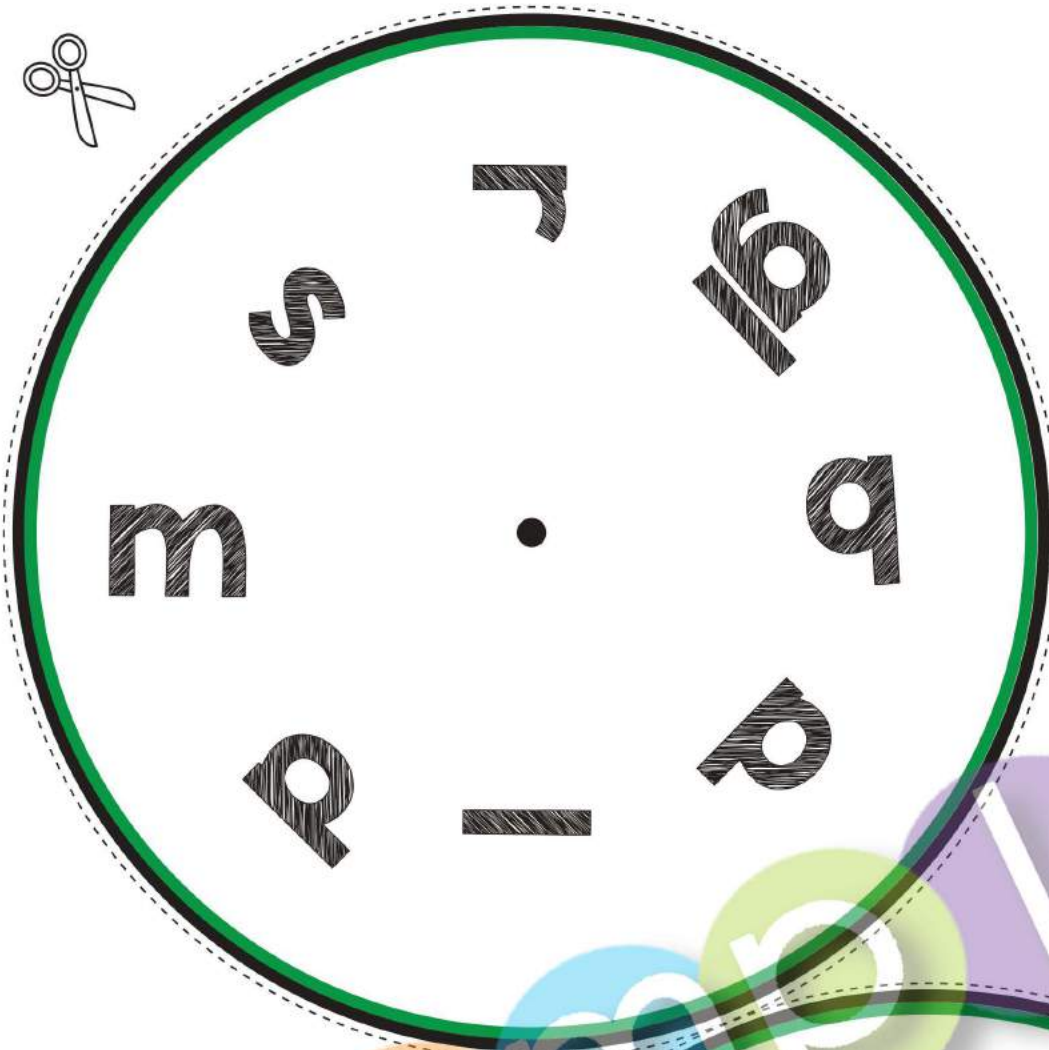

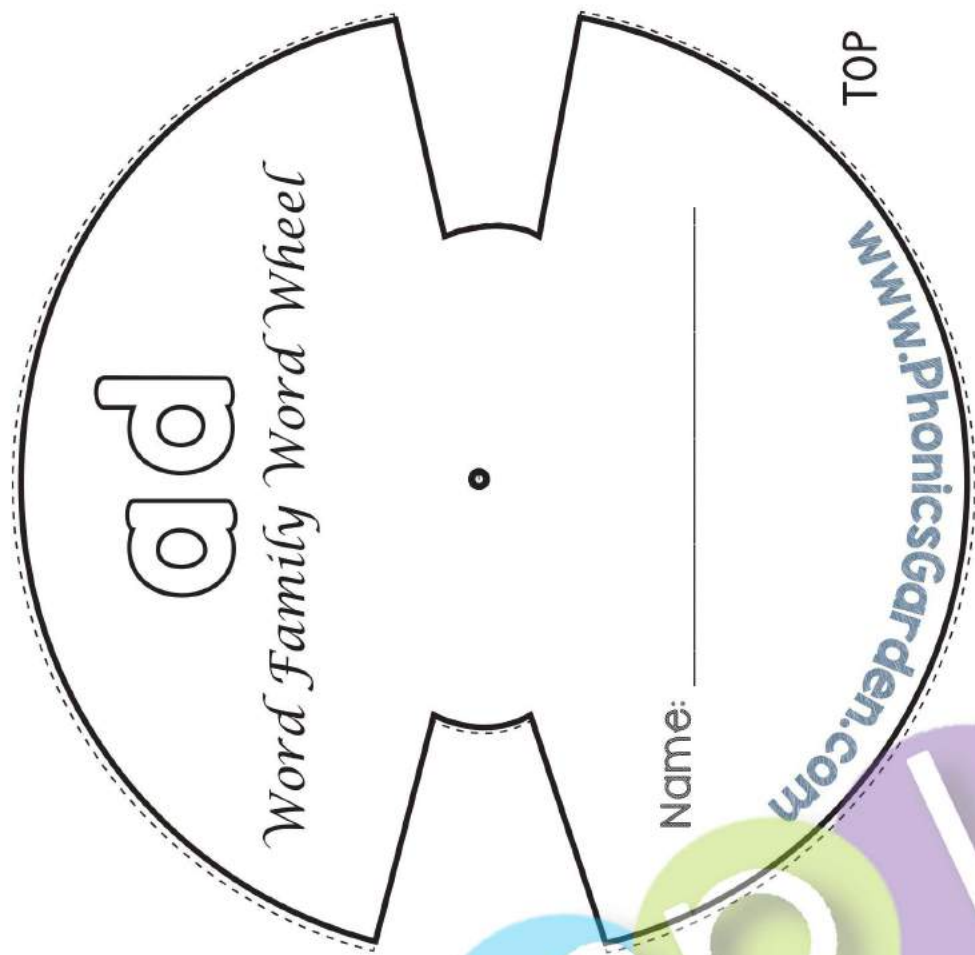
